

## Privacy Policy

In this document, "we", "our", or "us" refer to Wellspring Family Centre.

Our office is at 35 Neatherd Road, Dereham, Norfolk, NR19 2AE.

### Purpose

This Policy outlines the data protection policies and procedures we have adopted and to which we abide to. The purpose of this Policy and any other documents referred to in it, is to clearly list and identify the legal requirements, procedures and rights which must be established when we obtain, process, transfer and/or store your personal data. This Policy will assist you in understanding the obligations, responsibilities and rights which arise from the Data Protection Laws.

### Introduction

At Wellspring Family Centre, we are committed to protecting your privacy. This Policy explains when and why we collect personal information about people with whom we work, how we use it, the conditions under which we may disclose it to others and how we keep it secure. It applies to information we collect about:

- Visitors to our website.
- Those who contact us via the website contact form.
- Details taken over the phone.

We regard the lawful and correct treatment of personal information as integral to successful operation and to maintaining the confidence of the people we serve and communicate with. To this end we fully endorse and adhere to the principles of the relevant Laws.

Any questions regarding this Policy and our privacy practices should be sent to the contact information provided at the end of this Policy.

Please be aware that, in all circumstance, we will never collect sensitive information about you without your explicit consent. The personal information which we hold will be held securely in accordance with our internal security policy and the law.

### When you visit our website

When someone visits <https://www.wfcdereham.org/> we use a third party service, Google Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way which does not identify anyone. We do not make, and do not allow Google to make, any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website.

### When you contact us using the website contact form or phone number

Personally identifiable info sent by email or communicated over the phone will be kept confidential. Email monitoring or blocking software may also be used. Please be aware that you have a responsibility to ensure that any email you send to us is within the bounds of the law.

### When you enquire with us or make a complaint

When enquiries are submitted to us we will only use the information supplied to enable us to deal with the enquiry itself. When we receive a complaint from a person we make up a file containing the details of the complaint. We will only use the personal information we collect to process the complaint itself. We will keep personal information contained in complaint files in line with our retention policy. It will be retained in a secure environment and access to it will be restricted according to the 'need to know' principle.

### Use of your data

We shall access and use your Personal Data in accordance with your instructions and as is reasonably necessary:

- if we intend to use your personal data for the advertising and marketing of our services we shall seek your separate express consent and you are entitled to opt out of these services at any time;
- to respond to your requests, queries and problems;
- to inform you about any changes to our services and related notices, such as security and fraud notices.

### The uses of your data may include:

- Responding to a message on the website contact form.
- Dealing with an enquiry or request made through the phone number on the website.

## How you can access and update your information

Wellspring Family Centre tries to be as open as it can be in terms of giving people access to their personal information. You are entitled to request access to your personal data unless providing a copy would adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others. Individuals can find out if we hold any personal information by making a 'subject access request'. If we do hold information about you we will:

- give you a description of it;
- tell you why we are holding it;
- tell you who it could be disclosed to; and
- let you have a copy of the information in an intelligible form.

To make a request to Wellspring Family Centre for any personal information we may hold about you, you need to either put the request in writing and address it to us at the address provided at the end of this document, or email us. We may suggest that you put your request in writing to assist us in establishing your identity.

When responding to written requests Personal Data will only be disclosed if we can confirm your identity and/or sufficient supporting evidence is provided by you to establish your identity. These procedures are to ensure that the data is only given to a person who is entitled to receive it. If you agree, we will try to deal with your request informally, for example by providing you with the specific information you need over the telephone.

If we do hold information about you, you can ask us to correct, update, amend, or remove it without undue delay. Once receiving a request to remove your data we must erase your Personal Data without delay.

## Who has access to your information?

We will not sell or rent your information to third parties. We will not share your information with third parties for marketing purposes. There are times when we may need to share your Personal Data with third parties. For example:

- if we are under a duty to disclose or share your Personal Data in order to comply with any legal obligation, lawful requests, court orders and legal process.

When we use third party service providers, we disclose only the personal information that is necessary to deliver the service.

There are also circumstances where we can pass on personal data without consent, for example; to prevent and detect crime.

We will not release your information to third parties for them to use for their own direct marketing purposes, unless you have requested us to do so, or we are required to do so by law, for example, by a court order or for the purposes of prevention of fraud or other crime and to produce anonymised statistics.

## Your choices

### Data storage, transfer and security

Wellspring Family Centre takes security seriously. We take various steps to protect information you provide to us from loss, misuse, and unauthorised access or disclosure. These steps take into account the sensitivity of the information we collect, process and store, and the current state of technology. Our employees and contracted personnel are bound to our privacy policies, procedures and technologies which maintain the security of all your Personal Data from the point of collection to the point of destruction:

- We maintain data security by protecting the confidentiality, integrity and availability of your Personal Data. We ensure that the only people authorised to use your personal data can access it.
- We ensure your Personal Data is accurate and suitable for the purpose for which it is processed. We shall take appropriate security measures against unlawful and/or unauthorised processing of personal data, and against the accidental loss of, or damage to, your Personal Data.

Where we have given (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our websites, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share your password with anyone.
